Scientific Abstract Submission Guidelines

- 1) Only registered delegates are permitted to submit abstract for scientific presentation.
- 2) A delegate can present one paper or one poster.
- 3) Registered delegates can co-author to a maximum of two submitted abstracts.
- 4) Maximum of two co-author allowed for the poster presentation.
- 5) Only those delegates who are physically present at the convention are eligible to receive the presentation certificates.
- 6) Abstract should be not more than 250 words inclusive of title.
- 7) Original research, systematic reviews, unique case reports, case series and narrative reviews maybe presented.
- 8) Abstracts should preferably have objectives, methodology, results and conclusion for original research.
- 9) The presentation should be an original work. Any conflict arising regarding plagiarism will be directed to IAOMP ethical committee.
- 10) The abstract submissions by the post graduate students must be certified and signed by the Head of Department.
- 11) The duration of each scientific paper presentation will be 8 minutes followed by 2 minutes for discussion.
- 12) Poster presentations will be only in E – Poster format. Duration of poster presentation will be 3 minutes followed by 1 minute for discussion. Maximum of 3 slides in ppt format.
- 13) The time limits should be strictly adhered to.

- 14) Last date for receiving scientific abstracts is 10th May 2026. Any entries received thereafter will not be considered.
- 15) Session judges' decision is final.
- 16) The abstract must be sent to Email id: 23rdiaomppgconvention@gmail.com with a subject title "Abstract Submission—Delegate Registration Number"
